<u>Ylläs Cabins 4 Night / 5 Day Christmas Itinerary</u>

Day I - 23rd December

0700-1235	(time difference - Finland is 2 hours ahead of UK) Flights depart London
	Heathrow at approximately 0700 (3.5 hours flight time). On arrival coach
	transfer to Ylläsjärvi and the cabin of your choice with a stop en-route to
	collect thermal clothing (transfer time including collection of thermal clothing
	approximately I hour I5 mins). You will receive a guided tour of the cabin.
1400-1530	Lunch in the cabin.

- 1730-1930 Depart for a husky dog safari where you will learn about the lives of the huskies (5km).
- Dinner in the cabin.

Day 2 – 24th December

- 0800-1000 Breakfast in the cabin.
- 1000-1400 Transfer from your cabin for a 20-30 minute reindeer ride (2km) that will take you through the snowy landscape to the reindeer herders' cabins and the Magic Forest. Join in tandem skiing, snow shoe walking and tobogganing. BBQ sausages on open fire. Children can drive mini snowmobiles, make Christmas decorations and ginger bread cookies. Meet Santa on an individual family basis in his cabin in the forest. Santa reads children's letters and gives them each a small soft toy gift. A simple Lappish lunch is served in the cabin in the forest. Coffee, tea, warm juice and gingerbread cookies are served throughout your stay in the forest. Return to your cabin at approximately 1430.
 1900 Dinner in the cabin.

Day 3 – 25th December

0800-1000 Breakfast in the cabin. Morning free.

Lunch in the cabin.

After receiving safety and driving instructions you depart for a snowmobile safari. Adults can drive snowmobiles through the Lappish countryside and forests, whilst children and those who do not wish to drive are pulled behind in sleighs. Stop in the forest at a wilderness restaurant for refreshments. Adults



have the opportunity to drive further whilst the children can stay in the wilderness restaurant (at least one adult from the family needs to stay with child/children).

Dinner in the cabin.

Day 4 – 26th December

0800-1000 Breakfast in the cabin.

- 1030-1230 Insta-Safari this easy-going safari, in the warmth of the bus, will let you see and take pictures of the most picturesque locations in Ylläs: breath-taking views over the Lappish forest and the National Park hills, ancient rock formations, impressive frozen trees and lakes to name but a few. The route takes you to one of the most beautiful lakes in Lapland, Kesänkijärvi, hidden between two majestic hills. The lake is known to be plentiful with trout and whitefish and you will have a chance to drill holes in the ice and try your luck at catching some fish. On the way back to Ylläsjärvi stop in Äkäslompolo and have one hour free for shopping: souvenirs, clothes, sport shop, groceries and also the only Alko Shop in the area. Or go and enjoy a beer or a warm drink at the local pub!
 1230-1400 Lunch in the cabin. Afternoon free.
- Dinner in the cabin.

Day 5 – 27th December

0800-1000	Breakfast in the cabin.
	Morning free.
00- 200	Check-out (you will be asked to leave your luggage in the safari house).
1200-1330	Lunch in Yllasrinne Hotel restaurant.
1400	Transfer to Kittilä airport (approximately 40 mins).
1700	Return flight to UK.
1840	Arrive UK.

- Please note that a full, valid driving license is required to drive a snowmobile.
- A list of optional activities will be supplied once in Lapland. All major credit and debit cards are accepted as well as cash in Euros.

As such you will have less direct contact with a Magic of Lapland guide, as we do not wish to disturb you on your holiday. Our Lappish guides, who speak English fluently, will accompany you on all activities.
