## Arctic Break 4 night / 5 Day Itinerary

### Day 1

- 0700-1235 (time difference - Finland is 2 hours ahead of UK) Flights depart London Heathrow at approximately 0700 (3.5 hours flight time). On arrival, coach transfer to Lodge67N (transfer time approximately 40 mins). Thermal clothing delivered to Lodge67N on arrival.
- 1430-1530 Lunch in Lodge 67°N.
- 1630-1700 Opportunity to change thermal clothing.
- 1900 Depart for Maybe Northern Lights Snowmobile Safari – 2.5 hours, 20-25km

### Day 2

- 0800-1000 Breakfast in Lodge 67°N.
- 1000 Across the Seven Fells Snowmobile Safari – 3.5 hours, 45km.
- 1800-2000 Dinner in Lodge 67°N.

### Day 3

- 0800-1000 Breakfast in Lodge 67°N.
- 1400 Half Day Husky Adventure – 4 hours, 25km
- 1800-1930 Dinner in Lodge 67°N.

### Day 4

- 0800-1000 Breakfast in Lodge 67°N.
- 1400 Reindeer Ride into the Wilderness – 2.5 hours (ride is 45 mins), 3km.
- 1800-1930 Dinner in Lodge 67°N.

### Day 5

- 0800-0930 Breakfast in Lodge 67°N.
- 0930 National Park & Kellostpuli Snowshoe trek – 4 hours, 8km
- 1400 Depart for airport (short stop en route for souvenir shopping).
- 1700 Return flight to UK.
- 1830 Arrive UK.

### Notes:

- Meals are delivered by our catering company. Lodge 67°N does not have a full hotel kitchen/restaurant and due to strict alcohol laws in Finland Lodge 67°N is unable to serve alcohol but we provide a welcome basket with wine and refreshment which can
