



Torassieppi Reindeer Farm Festive Break | 3-night Break



Twin Room / Interconnecting Room Amenities:

The twin rooms are located in cabins, each with a private entrance and no shared facilities. Every twin room features two single beds, a bathroom with a wet room, and a small sitting area. An extra bed can be added to accommodate a child. Interconnecting rooms consist of two twin rooms joined by an internal door, and together they can sleep up to six people. The cabins are located approximately 50 metres from the restaurant.

Sample Itinerary 3-night Itinerary

Afternoon: arrive at Kittilä Airport and coach transfer to the Torassieppi Reindeer Farn (about 1 hour). Collect thermal clothing on arrival.

Mid-Afternoon: Play in the Snow & Make Decorations

Enjoy snow fun activities by the nearby lake, including tobogganing, children's snowmobiles, ice fishing, and more. You can also participate in making festive decorations during this time. Dinner

Day 2 Breakfast

Morning: 5km Husky Safari and Visit to the Husky Farm

Experience the thrill of a husky safari at a working husky farm, where you'll meet some of the friendly and energetic dogs that call Lapland home. Embark on an unforgettable 5km husky safari where you will



be driven through the breathtaking Arctic wilderness by professional mushers. After your ride, warm up with a hot drink by the fire and take the opportunity to ask the mushers about the lives of these incredible sled dogs—how they train, race, and thrive in the snowy landscapes of Lapland. Lunch

Mid-Afternoon: Make Cookies & Private Visit to Santa

Bake gingerbread cookies in the restaurant before enjoying a private visit with Santa, who will listen to your Christmas wishes, chat about your year, and share in the festive spirit. Each child will receive a special gift, creating a truly magical and memorable experience for the whole family. Dinner

Evening: Pancakes by the Lake and Waiting for the Northern Lights

After dinner, gather by the fire in the lakeside kota to enjoy pancakes while keeping an eye out for the Northern Lights. With a little luck, you may witness this incredible display. Your knowledgeable guide will be on hand to share fascinating insights about this awe-inspiring natural phenomenon.

Day 3 Breakfast

Morning: Visit to the Historic Reindeer Ride & Reindeer Safari

The original Torassieppi Reindeer Farm homestead, dating back to the 19th century, offers a unique window into the past. After your 3km reindeer safari through the Lappish wilderness, your expert guide will lead an informative talk about Sámi culture and reindeer husbandry in the farm's museum. Lunch

Afternoon: 1.5 hour Snowmobile Safari

Embark on a snowmobile safari through the untouched Lappish wilderness. After receiving driving instructions, safety equipment, and advice, you'll set off on the safari. Two adults will share a snowmobile, and children will ride in a sleigh pulled behind the guide's snowmobiles. You will be able to swap drivers at the halfway point.

Day 4 Breakfast and check-out

Morning: Free

The morning is free for you to pack and check out.





Lunch

Afternoon: Visit to the Sámiland Museum and the Town of Levi

On your way to the airport, you'll stop at the Sámiland Museum, where you can learn more about the culture of Europe's only Indigenous people. Afterwards, you'll have some time to explore the small ski town of Levi, with its shops, cafés, and restaurants — all within easy walking distance.

Location: Situated in the Muonio region, Finland, approx. 200km north of the Arctic

Circle.

Average Temperatures: 0C to -45C

Daylight: Ist – I4th December approx. I hour – 30 mins.

 $14^{th}-31^{st}$ December 0 hours of daylight. This is the special time of Kaamos or Polar Night when the sun does not go above the horizon. There is a twilight light

between 10:00 and 14:00.

Northern Lights: This is a great location to see the Northern Lights. Should the Aurora appear,

you will be able to see them from your accommodation.

Santa Experience: If your children write letters to Santa, we can make sure he receives them

before your visit. Each child will receive a special letter from Santa, personally inviting them to Lapland, as well as a soft toy to cherish during their visit.

Local Area: Torassieppi Reindeer Farm is a secluded location, bordered by frozen lakes on

one side and woodland on the other. It is not near any larger villages or towns.



The nearest village, Muonio, is about 20 minutes away by taxi and has a supermarket and a pharmacy, but most guests choose to stay on the farm throughout their visit..

Food:

The farm serves a variety of home-style meals, including breakfast items like eggs and cereals, as well as salmon, white fish, elk, reindeer, beef, chicken, pasta, potatoes, vegetables, and more. Meals are a combination of buffet and table service. Please note that separate children's meals are not available, though the kitchen is happy to help where possible. A festive dinner featuring traditional Lappish cuisine will include glow-fried salmon, mushroom soup, Lappish berries, and more, all served in a traditional Lappish wooden tepee.

Currency:

The local currency is the Euro, but nearly all shops, restaurants, and taxis accept card payments, making transactions convenient and hassle-free.
