




# Ylläs Cabins Festive Break

# Day 2 Breakfast

# Morning: Visit to a Wilderness Location for Snow Fun Activities & Private Visit to Santa

Transfer to a nearby wilderness location (approximately 25 minutes by coach) for various snow activities including a reindeer ride, snowshoe walking, kick sledging, and tobogganing. Indoors, you can enjoy decorating gingerbread cookies and making Christmas decorations.

Lunch will be served throughout the day. Each family will receive an invitation from Santa with your scheduled time for a visit. Each family will have a private audience with Santa, and each child will receive a soft toy as a gift.

## Mid-Afternoon: Relax & Explore

After arriving back at the cabin around 15:00, enjoy free time to relax and explore—warm up and relax or head back out for more snowy fun!


#### Day 3 Breakfast

#### Morning: 5km Husky Safari and Visit to the Husky Farm

Experience the thrill of a husky safari at a working husky farm, where you'll meet some of the friendly and energetic dogs that call Lapland home. After an introduction to mushing, you'll take the lead and embark on an unforgettable 5km husky safari through the breathtaking Arctic wilderness.

After your ride, warm up with a hot drink by the fire and take the opportunity to ask the mushers about the lives of these incredible sled dogs—how they train, race, and thrive in the snowy landscapes of Lapland.

#### Afternoon: Children's Snowmobiles

Children can enjoy riding mini snowmobiles on dedicated tracks, designed just for them. The snowmobiling area is conveniently located near a small supermarket, making it easy to pick up any snacks before heading back to your cabin.

# Day 4 Breakfast and check-out

### Morning: 20 - 25km Snowmobile Safari

Embark on a snowmobile safari through the untouched Lappish wilderness. After receiving driving instructions, safety equipment, and advice, you'll set off on the safari. Two adults will share a snowmobile, and children (or those who do not wish to drive) will ride in a sleigh pulled behind the guide's snowmobiles.

The safari covers 20 - 25 km, with a stop halfway in the forest for warm drinks and snacks. As two adults share each snowmobile, you can swap drivers after the break.

# Flight Information


Provisional flight times with our British Airways charter:

Location: Situated in the village of Ylläsjärvi in the Ylläs region, Finland, approx.

200km north of the Arctic Circle.

Average Temperatures: 0C to -45C

Daylight: Ist – I4th December approx. I hour – 30 mins.

 $14^{th} - 31^{st}$  December 0 hours of daylight. This is the special time of Kaamos or Polar Night when the sun does not go above the horizon. There is a twilight light

between 10:00 and 14:00.

Northern Lights: This is a great location to see the Northern Lights. Should the Aurora appear,

you will be able to see them from your cabin.

Santa Experience: If your children write letters to Santa, we can make sure he receives them

before your visit. Each child will receive a special letter from Santa, personally inviting them to Lapland, as well as a soft toy to cherish during their visit.

Local Area: The cabins are a few minutes taxi ride from the village centre, where you'll find

a supermarket and a café.

Food: Our catering company delivers your meals directly to your cabin, as well as

Skiing: Downhill skiing is just a 5-minute taxi ride away. Booking ski equipment and lift
